Comparison of Ambient Temperatures from 'Doner Report' to Modern Day Ambient Temperatures for the Same Geographic Areas

Questions and Answers

Are the detailed temperature data from the Doner report available in digital form, and if so, can this be provided to us? **The only electronic version of the original "Doner Report" to which we are aware is PDF scans of the original 1972 report. See attached.**

As stated in the RFP, the modern temperature data developed in this project are to be statistically compared to the data in the Doner Report "using an approved statistician." Can CRC provide us with a list of approved statisticians? **CRC can provide names of previously used statisticians and/or the winning bid can submit a name of a statistician to be considered and "approved" for the project.**

Is the Doner Report data already available in electronic format for use in map and statistical comparisons, or is getting this data in electronic format part of the project scope? **The only electronic version of the original "Doner Report" to which we are aware is PDF scans of the original 1972 report. See attached.**

Could you please clarify what is meant in the RFP that the station list should be "expanded to include additional stations which have been created since the original data were generated." There have been a large number of stations created since the Doner Report. Is the expectation to include all of them (whenever available), or was this statement simply meant to refer to the addition of the Hawaii data? **CRC would like for the winning bid to identify additional stations, if available. The panel can then decide if they should be included.**
