The 29th Real World Emissions Workshop will be held March 10-13, 2019 at the Renaissance Long Beach Hotel in Long Beach CA. The objective of the Workshop is to share information about recent and ongoing research in real world transportation emissions. The main topics of interest include:

- Air Quality
- Emissions Modeling
- Off-Road / Nonroad Emissions
- Emissions Measurement Methods
- Fuel Effects on Exhaust Emissions
- Improving the Emissions Inventory
- Particulate Emissions and Measurement
- Emissions Control Measures (I/M) and OBD
- In-Use Emissions for Light- and Heavy-Duty Vehicles

Over 240 participants, including researchers from twelve countries participated in the 2018 workshop, which was co-sponsored by the California Air Resources Board, the U.S. Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory, the South Coast Air Quality Management District, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and the Truck and Engine Manufacturers Association.

Presentations should not be of a marketing or promotional nature.
